BIENNIAL PRIZE FOR YOUNG SCHOLARS WORKING ON EUROPEAN BANKING HISTORY

The European Association for Banking History will award a prize to either an individual scholar, or a team involving no more than three scholars, working on either an institutional, economic or social aspect of the history of European banking or a banking dynasty. The arising study should meet academic requirements, be unpublished and comprise 80–120,000 words. Applicants should not be more than 35 years of age when submitting their manuscripts. Texts will be accepted in any European language but must be accompanied by an abstract of 3,000 words/10 pages in English.

The prize of 2,500 ecu will be awarded in Amsterdam in 1999. In addition, the EABH will endeavour to publish the prize-winning manuscript.
