from the early 1920 s and he has flown, or attempted to fly, some of the very earliest types — It is probably safe to say that no man in this country has been a more ardent crusader on their behalf

In his earlier official capacity at the Air Ministry, and later at the Ministry of Aircraft Production, Group Captain Liptrot was largely concerned with the development in this field, and for some years before his retirement in April, 1949, he held the appointment of Deputy Director of Research and Development (Helicopters) at the Ministry of Supply, in which capacity he devoted his whole time to helicopter development. He is, of course, a Founder Member of the Association, and he served on the Executive Council from 1947 to 1952.
