## Sixth International Palaeolimnology Symposium

19-21 April 1993

Inter-INQUA. The context of this conference is the IGBP priorities related to the broader Australian region, including the Indian, western Pacific, and Antarctic Ocean areas. We will contrast new regional records with global data, and the meeting will act as a forum to report progress in the Past Global Changes Project (PAGES) and Palaeoclimates of the Northern and Southern Hemispheres (PANASH). Papers on three themes are invited: Marine and Terrestrial Records: Do They Agree?; Environments of Human Settlement; and Climatic Processes and Landscape Response. The climate theme will play an integrative role for the other two themes and will address the integration of inland and coastal climatic histories and rates of climatic switching. Tropical climates during the Quaternary, especially in monsoon regions, will be emphasized.

Sixth International Palaeolimnology Symposium. This meeting will cover arid and tropical/subtropical environments, high-resolution sequences, dating methods, and the contribution of palaeolimnology to IGBP. Presentation of multidisciplinary research on lake sequences is highly encouraged under the following themes: Palaeolimnology in Arid Regions; Palaeolimnology in Tropical/Subtropical Regions; High-Resolution Sequences; and Dating Methods.
