LIBRARIES AND ARCHIVES

Yucatan Materials Microfilmed by University of Alabama

The University of Alabama has recently completed the microfilming of materials in the library of the Instituto Yucateco de Antropología e Historia and the library of the state of Yucatan. To date, a total of 119 rolls of microfilm have been catalogued by the University of Alabama library.

American Philosophical Society Sponsors Archival Work in Spain

During the academic years 1967–68 and 1968–69, the American Philosophical Society has sponsored archival work in the Archivo de Indias, Sevilla, Spain. Supporting grants have been provided by the participating institutions—the University of Pennsylvania University Museum and Department of Anthropology and the Instituto de Cultura Hispánica, Madrid. The objectives of the program are to collect and microfilm documents containing information on Spaniards in the early colonial period in the New World, to make use of the documents for ethnographic reconstruction and interpretation of the culture of the societies of the period, and to train anthropology students in ethno-historical research. The first stage of the study has focused on documentation for Guatemala; documents concerned with varied aspects of the society of the

region during the first century of the colonial era have been isolated for micro-filming and summarized, transcribed, and indexed. The project continues under the direction of Ruben E. Reina, University of Pennsylvania, Alfredo Jimenez, Universidad de Sevilla, and Edward O'Flaherty, S.J., University of Pennsylvania.

Centro Editor de América Latina Reproduces Rare Titles

The Centro Editor de América Latina, S.A. is preparing a new publications collection, entitled Ediciones Facsimilares Americanas, which is to consist of photolithographed reproductions of works which are rarely found in libraries or bookstores but which bear relevance to the history of Latin America. To be included among the first titles distributed are: *Reflexiones sobre las causas morales de las convulsiones interiores en los nuevos estados americanos, y examen de los medios para reprimirlas* by Juan Ignacio de Gorriti; *Francisco Moyén, o lo que fué la Inquisición en América* by Benjamín Vicuña Mackenna; and *La independencia de Venezuela* by Bartolomé Mitre. This collection is but one of many organized by the center; others include La Urbanización en América Latina, Enciclopedia Literaria, Libros de Buenos Aires, and "Bibliotecas" on literature, psychology, sociology, education, chemistry, mathematics, and economics. Creole Foundation Presents Library on Venezuela to UCLA

The Creole Foundation, a public service institution in Venezuela, presented in February 1969 a Minimum Library on Venezuelan History and Culture to the University of California, Los Angeles. To be utilized as an instrument of teaching, on the university level, beyond the frontiers of Venezuela, the collection consists of 118 titles, with a total of 145 volumes, referring to fundamental aspects of Venezuelan life. The Center for Latin American Studies at the University of California, Berkeley, initiated a Dissertation Prize in April 1967. The prize is awarded for an excellent dissertation in the social sciences and humanities written by a graduate student at the university. The dissertation must deal specifically with Latin American topics. Consideration takes place each fall and spring quarter,
