In my recent review of Stanley Wolpert's *Jinnah of Pakistan* published in your Journal, I regret that, through mis-reading my own notes, I gave a wrong impression of what he wrote (p. 39) about the tension in the Muslim League in 1915 between Maulana Hasrat Mohani and Jinnah. The remarks I attributed to Mohani taunting Jinnah that his westernisation showed his unfitness to lead the Muslims, were those of mullahs, not of Mohani.

Naturally, I am sorry that my slip might call in question Dr. Wolpert's historical accuracy, with those who have not read his admirable book. I offer him and your Journal my apologies.
