**Cover picture:** Farnborough 1974, fully inter-national for the first time, was remarkable, *inter alia*, for the range of aircraft shown by Lock-heeds. The company could well have claimed that their trio were the fastest, largest and quietest aircraft in the show. In the case of the SR-71 and the Galaxy there is no dispute, but with the TriStar the measurement of noise is not quite so clear cut as that of speed and size. The story of the TriStar, the first of an initial British Air-ways order for nine aircraft is shown on the cover, was the sub-ject of the Fifteenth Fairey Mem-orial Lecture, given by L. E. Frisbee last autumn, and published in this issue.

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
