Each typescript should include: (i) an abstract of not more than 150 words, preferably containing no formulae, and certainly containing no complicated formulae and no references, (ii) a 1980 Mathematics subject classification (Amer. Math. Soc.); the classification scheme is described in Mathematical Reviews, Index to Volume 56 (1978), (iii) if the title is long, a shortened form of it, no more than forty characters in length, including spaces.
