## THE GUIDE OF THE PERPLEXED

*Maimonides*

*Translated with an introduction and notes by Shlomo Pines and with an Introductory Essay by Leo Strauss.* Written at the end of the twelfth century, this monument of rabbinical exegesis not only has exerted an immense and continuing influence upon Jewish thought but was a formative element in the thinking of leading Christian writers and philosophers until the seventeenth century. Maimonides claimed that every word he used was chosen with infinite care. 
