

*Dimensions:* head and neck 1·25 mm., trunk 3·2 mm., abdominal appendages 0·7 mm., eggstrings 2 mm., second maxillae 4·8 mm. (Fig. 6).

**Diagnosis.** *Cephalothorax* flattened dorsally; a slight dorsal carapace. *Neck* not segmented. *Trunk* pyriform. *Abdominal appendages* small and stout. *Eggstrings* stout, shorter than trunk. *Second maxillae* extremely long, longer than trunk, straight with expanded apices. *Bulla* resembling that of *Lernaeopoda*. A very small species.
