PIT PONIES

There are still 13,400 used (and stabled) underground in British coalmines. No other country has such an enormous number. They should not be worked in mines for more than 11 years, and have a holiday on the surface every year. Electric battery lamps should be fixed to their collars, or their roadways electrically lit. Small ponies under 14 hands high should not be employed, and ample dimensions for comfortable travel always guaranteed. They should not be used on steep inclines or overloaded. The pace at which pit ponies work is much faster than that above ground and even if their drivers were invariably kind, their life cannot be a happy one. Nobody outside the employment of the National Coal Board or the Ministry of Fuel ever sees the ponies actually at work below ground or when brought up for good and destroyed. Why not a time limit to the use of ponies in mines? Why not an independent inquiry into what can be done in this way? Contributions gratefully received.—D.
