JERRY STANNARD MEMORIAL AWARD

The 1994 Stannard Award competition is open to graduate students and to recipients of a doctoral degree (PhD or equivalent) conferred not more than three years before the competition deadline. Published or unpublished essays dealing with the history of *materia medica*, medicinal botany, pharmacy, and folklore of drug therapy before 1700 are considered. In 1994, the award will be \$250.

The manuscripts must be in English, French, or German. Only one paper by an author may be submitted in any given year. Each entry should be typewritten, double-spaced, and no longer than 50 pages in total. Submitted manuscripts will not be returned. Each manuscript must be accompanied by a one-page abstract of the paper *in English*, a current *curriculum vitae* of the author, and a letter of recommendation from an established scholar in the field. Entries must be received no later than 15 February 1994. The award will be announced on or about the 15 May 1994.
