It is hoped to publish the remaining four parts at intervals of one or two years.

This Dictionary, the fruit of many years' work and of help from other scholars, aims at utilizing the stock of texts (so greatly multiplied in recent years) to illustrate the Coptic vocabulary in all its dialects and in all the aspects of its literature—biblical, patriotic, and mundane. It naturally includes a large number of words not to be found in any previous dictionary—about one-sixth, for instance, of those in the first fascicle.
