BULGARIAN COMMUNIST PARTY BYLAWS: TRANSLATION

Dr. Ivan Sipkov, who has recently been appointed the new Chief of the European Law Division in the Law Library of the Library of Congress, Washington, D.C., U.S.A., has translated from Bulgarian into English the current Bylaws of the Bulgarian Communist Party (BCP). These bylaws were adopted at the 8th Congress of the BCP in 1962, and amended at the 9th and 10th Congresses held respectively in 1966 and 1971. The translation, together with a historical introduction by Dr. Sipkov and a text of the bylaws in Bulgarian, are published in a separate issue in the Library of Congress Law Library Publications series. It bears the 1980 publication date, and is available upon request from the Law Librarian, Law Library, Library of Congress, Washington, D.C. 20540, U.S.A.
