

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The name of the author at the beginning of the paper should be followed only by senior qualifications.

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Two copies of the typescript should be provided, double spaced throughout, on one side of quarto or A4 paper. Tables and legends for illustrations should be typed separately at the end of the manuscript. All pages should be numbered serially and fastened together securely. Words to be printed in italic should be underlined. The first mention of Latin names of species should be followed by the authority except where reference is made to a work in which the authority appears (e.g. Plymouth Marine Fauna).

All linear measurements and weights should be in the metric scale.

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All illustrations will be reduced to a size not exceeding 20×14 cm. No illustrations should be submitted which will not fit into an envelope 30.5×40.7 cm (12×16 inches).

Lettering, numerals, etc. should be marked clearly in pencil and the exact position in which they are to be inserted should be indicated. Symbols on the figure should be kept to a minimum and details given in the legend.

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
