DIPLOMA IN PSYCHIATRY**

An intensive five weeks' Postgraduate Course as part of the requirements for the Diploma in Psychiatry will be held during the Autumn Term, 1952, from Monday, 6 October to Saturday, 8 November. The course will include instruction in Psychiatry, Psychology, Neurology, Neuro-Anatomy, Neuro-Physiology, Neuro-Pathology, Mental Deficiency, etc., and will occupy the full time of those attending.

While primarily intended for medical graduates or licentiates who have been registered as candidates for the Diploma in Psychiatry of the University, the course is open to other medical practitioners who may wish to attend.

The fee for the course is 25 guineas and a matriculation fee of £1 11s. 6d. (or £2 12s. 6d. in the case of candidates for the Diploma) is also payable.

The course will be held only if a sufficient number of enrolments is received, and application for admission to the course should be sent to the DEAN OF THE FACULTY OF MEDICINE, University New Buildings, Edinburgh, 8, NOT LATER THAN 30 JUNE, 1952.

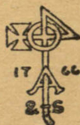
