Transactions of the Faculty of Actuaries.

DEAR SIR.

Referring to my letter of 3rd June 1949, published on page 100 of Volume XIX of the *Transactions*, the Table herewith gives the percentages invested in various classes of securities as at 31st December 1949 by the ten Life Offices in respect of which similar figures were given in the Appendix to Mr. A. C. Murray's Paper, "The Investment Policy of Life Assurance Offices" (*T.F.A.*, vol. xvi. p. 263).

The corresponding percentages as at 31st December 1948 are also given. In comparing these with the 1949 figures, it will be recalled that, as at 1st May 1949, stocks and shares of undertakings in the British Gas Industry were exchanged for Gas Stock guaranteed by the British Government. Nevertheless, the total amount invested in British Government Securities by the ten Offices shows a reduction on the year of nearly £3,000,000 and the percentage so invested is reduced from 31.8 to 29.6, as shown in the Table.
