JOHN NORBERT DECK



The Editors have learned with sharp regret that Professor John Norbert Deck died suddenly of a heart attack at his home on Wednesday, September 5, 1979, at the age of 57.

Professor Deck received his B.A. and M.A. in philosophy from the University of Western Ontario through Assumption University of Windsor, the latter being affiliated with the former at the time. He received his Ph.D. from the University of Toronto in 1960. After teaching at Boston College for two years (1955–57) he joined the staff of the Philosophy Department at the University of Windsor where he remained for the rest of his career (1957–79). He was one of the most well known and respected teachers in the Department and was very popular with both undergraduate and graduate students.

Among his colleagues he was best known as a Plotinus scholar and for his book *Nature*, *Contemplation and the One*.

Dr. Deck was married and had nine children.
