

The Society for Healthcare Epidemiology of America is seeking candidates for the position of Editor-in-Chief for *Infection Control and Hospital Epidemiology (ICHE)*. The editor of *ICHE* will chair the editorial advisory board and be supported by the editorial office and the editorial staff; will supervise the editorial content and substance of the journal; will serve as a decision maker in situations involving manuscripts suitable for publication; will serve as the Society's liaison with the publisher, the University of Chicago Press, and assure that services are provided in a manner that promotes *ICHE's* integrity and the Society's professional reputation; will promote communication among the many individuals involved in the publication; will propose innovation in the journal's content, emphasis, and form; will represent the journal at meetings with organizations and individuals interested in *ICHE*; will attend Board of Directors, Publication Committee, and Editorial Board meetings as necessary, and provide reports on the progress and activities of the journal.
