DRUG-INDUCED NEUROLOGICAL DISORDERS. Second revised and expanded edition. 2001. By K.K. Jain. Published by Hogrefe & Huber Publishers. 474 pages. C\$118.00 approx.

Dr. Jain is a neurologist and a neurosurgeon who brings both his personal clinical experience and his experience as a medical advisor to pharmaceutical companies to this excellent monograph. It is

unusual, these days, to find a book of this breadth and depth that is single-authored. Single authorship does ensure consistency across chapters and prevents some of the redundancy that may be found in multi-authored texts of this type.
