## JERRY STANNARD MEMORIAL AWARD

The 1993 Stannard Award competition is open to graduate students and recent recipients of a doctoral degree conferred not more than three years before the competition deadline. Published or unpublished essays dealing with the history of *materia medica*, medicinal botany, pharmacy, or folklore of drug therapy before the year 1700 are considered.

Manuscripts must be in English, French, or German. Each entry should be typewritten, double-spaced, and no longer than 50 pages, including notes, bibliography and appendices. Submitted manuscripts will not be returned. Each manuscript must be accompanied by a one-page abstract of the paper in **English**, a current *curriculum vitae* of the author, and a letter of recommendation from an established scholar in the field. Entries must be received no later than **15 February 1993**. The award of \$250.00 will be announced on or about 15 May 1993.
