A permanent position as Associate Professor is available at the Laboratory of Actuarial Mathematics.

The successful candidate will have a strong research program, and will be qualified to teach within the central areas of actuarial mathematics; teaching comprises participation in the undergraduate and the graduate program as well as graduate supervision. The position also carries with it a share of the administrative work at the Laboratory.

The central areas of research at the Laboratory are: individual behaviour in risky situations; optimal exchange of risk; modelling of insurance risk portfolios in life insurance and general insurance as well as reinsurance; loss reserving; solvency control; allocation of premium and distribution of surplus; stochastic processes in insurance and finance.
