AUSTRALIAN MATHEMATICAL SOCIETY

The seventh general meeting of the Society will take place at Monash University, Clayton, Victoria, on May 21st, 22nd, 23rd, 1963.

The Society was founded in 1956, and has held yearly meetings since that date. At these meetings papers on all branches of pure and applied mathematics and mathematical statistics are read. The meetings are attended by 80 to 100 mathematicians from the whole of Australia, and in the past, visitors from New Zealand, the United Kingdom, the United States of America, and Japan have been present.

The Society has for its objects "the promotion and extension of mathematical knowledge". There are about 250 members at present, most of them are either in University posts or Government establishments. The activities of the Society, apart from the general meetings include publication of the "Journal of the Australian Mathematical Society", a Summer Research Institute, and organizing a Seminar on Mathematical Education.
