

If a manuscript is accepted for publication it must be translated into English. Potential contributors who cannot arrange for the translation of their manuscripts should contact the Editor-in-Chief.

Reviewing of Manuscripts

Each manuscript (with author's name(s) removed) is evaluated by at least two reviewers, usually members of the Editorial Board, and authors are sent copies of the reviewers' comments together with the decision on publication. It is a condition of acceptance that manuscripts have not already appeared in print (with limited exceptions for manuscripts which have been published in certain languages other than English).
