- foster cooperation among persons and organizations concerned with the scholarly study of the Middle East.

MESA focuses on the study of the Middle East since the rise of Islam, principally from the viewpoint of the humanities and the social sciences. Its membership is international.

Persons of scholarly training and/or achievement in Middle East studies are eligible to become Full Members. Other categories of membership are Associate, Student and Institutional. Each application is acted upon individually, and membership is on a calendar-year basis. Membership includes subscriptions to the *International Journal of Middle East Studies*, the *MESA Bulletin* and the *MESA Newsletter*.
