

GUIDELINES FOR THE TRANSPORTATION OF LIVE ANIMALS

At the 1981 meeting of the Parties to the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora, held in New Delhi, the delegates approved the adoption of the above Guidelines which were originally drafted under the supervision of John A. Burton, Executive Secretary of the ffPS.

All Parties to CITES are now expected to ensure that animals are shipped in compliance with these Guidelines.
