I. THIRD INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON TRICHINELLOSIS MIAMI, FLORIDA U.S.A.

November 2-4, 1972

The Third International Conference on Trichinellosis will be held at the Sheraton Four Ambassadors Hotel, Miami, Florida, on November 2–4, 1972. The conference will immediately precede the joint meeting of the American Society of Parasitologists and the American Society of Tropical Medicine and Hygiene. It will be comprehensive in scope, and authors are invited to submit the titles of proposed papers on any topic relating to *Trichinella spiralis*. The Conference will include symposia on major aspects of trichinellosis, including epidemiology, bionomics, pathology, immunology, treatment and control.

Titles of papers should be received by the Secretary-Treasurer not later than January 1, 1972; and abstracts, of not more than 300 words, should be received before June 1, 1972.
