The first comprehensive catalogue of African publications lists over 6,000 titles from 188 African publishers, research institutions and other organizations with publishing interests in nineteen countries. Of the total number of titles, about one-fifth represent publications in sixty-eight different African languages.

The catalogue, which includes bibliographical data, prices and a directory of publishers, covers books, pamphlets, reports, annuals, yearbooks, and regular and irregular series, but not periodical publications or magazines. Works are arranged alphabetically in author, title and subject indexes. In particular, the subject sequence, which follows *Sears List of Subject Headings* with modifications, contains numerous form divisions and cross-references.

An editorial advisory board of distinguished librarians from Africa, the U.K. and U.S. together with correspondents in several African nations have helped to make this major new reference tool as authoritative as possible. To maintain currency, an updating service appears in Hans Zell's quarterly *African Book Publishing Record*. Part Two of *African Books in Print*, which will be a combined English and French language edition, is in preparation for publication in 1977. Future editions are planned to appear at two-yearly intervals.
