GUIDELINES

1. All communications and responses to communications will be reviewed for substantive relevance and consistency with the principles below.
2. No ad hominem arguments will be permitted.
3. Communications must be limited to 300 words or less.
5. If a communication is accepted for publication, the book reviewer will be given a chance to respond, subject to the preceding principles. These responses will be discouraged unless the author requires clarification or documentation or the reviewer notes further serious error in the author's remarks.
