# TWENTY EIGHTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY BUSINESS SESSIONS 

FIRST SESSION: Tuesday, 21 August 2012, 16:30-18:00<br>Chaired by Robert Williams, President of the IAU<br>China National Convention Centre, Beijing

## 1. Opening and Welcome

- the National Representative for Finance, in their capacity to discuss and vote on financial matters, as well as to propose nominations and elect the Finance Committee (formerly known as Finance Sub-Committee) for the triennium;
- the National Representatives for Membership Nominations, in they capacity to discuss and vote on individual membership issues, as well as to propose nominations and elect the Special Nominating Committee (SNC), and the Membership Committee.

For each National Member, the first line gives the names of the Representatives present during the first week of the GA, the second line, if present, gives the names of the Representatives present during the second week of the GA.

## 10. Presentation of Proposed Changes to Divisional Structure

The Assistant General Secretary, Dr. Thierry Montmerle, presented proposed changes to the IAU Divisional structure, endorsed by the Division Presidents and the Executive Committee, in the form of a Resolution put to the General Assembly, as follows:

## RESOLUTION B4

on the restructuring of the IAU Divisions,
proposed by the IAU Executive Committee
The XXVIII General Assembly of the International Astronomical Union, noting
(a) that both the IAU and astronomy as a whole have evolved considerably since the current Divisions were introduced in 1994 and formally adopted in 1997, and that it is therefore appropriate to consider re-optimising the Divisional Structure,
(b) the report and recommendations of the Task Group established by the Executive Committee to examine the case for restructuring the Divisions, and the Executive Committee response to these recommendations,
(c) that the Commissions, Working Groups and other bodies under the Divisions may also require reform,
(d) that the implementation of the Strategic Plan through the Office of Astronomy for Development (OAD) and other associated programmes requires the Executive Committee to establish appropriate oversight and governance provisions for all Astronomy for Development activities, including the Office of Astronomy for Development, ensuring a strong link between these activities, the Divisions, and the Executive Committee.
