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Receipt of the paper will be confirmed and followed by a refereeing process, which will take about three months.

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- 5. Footnotes should be avoided as far as possible.
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- 7. Upon acceptance of a paper, any figures should be drawn in black ink on white paper in a form suitable for photographic reproduction with lettering of uniform size and sufficiently large to be legible when reduced to the final size.
