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GLUTAMATE THEORY OF DEPRESSION-NEW ELEMENTS

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Objectives: It is possible to develop in the close future new chemical products which could act in more effective way for the reduction or even cancelling of the symptoms determined by the alteration of major neurotransmitters-,GABA and glutamate.

Aims: Based on huge interconnection which exists between depression and drug dependence at various levels-especially through the effects exerted by particular anti depressant and some of anti craving medications ,it is possible to evaluate the impact which some new pharmaceutical compounds -derivated from glutamate type of receptor NMDA-might exert upon various types of depression elicited by patients with associated drug dependence.

Methods: Had been realised a thematical reanalysis of the studies published on Medline, EMBASE and OVID about this subject.

Results: The conclusion of the studies reveals the huge potential represented by treatment with some types of NMDA antagonists-Ketamine. The putative site of action is prefrontal cortex and is had been proved highly efficient in MDD patients.
