Volumes III-VII are to be issued within two years.

This work comprises six volumes of text in Chinese, German translation, an index and one volume including commentary. (Approx. 600 pages each). It must be purchased as a complete set. The publication has been prepared in collaboration with the "Mao's Writings Project", supervised by Professor Michael Y. M. Kau at Brown University, USA. A multi-volume set of Mao's writings is being translated into English at Brown University. It will be issued by M. E. Sharpe, Publisher, White Plains, New York.

Because of the power struggle going on for decades in the People's Republic, the Chinese documentation forming the basis for this edition can be found only in pamphlets with limited circulalation, copies and reprints, and in a regional publications. This is the first work to present the most important material published on domestic and foreign policy, economics and culture in the People's Republic of China. The original Chinese text is unedited, translated into German and analyzed. Thus historians and sociologists alike will find this an indispensable commentary on Chinese development.

This bilingual edition includes German translations and in the unedited Chinese text, all of Mao Zedong's writings collected by the Mao Zedong research project at the Hamburg Institute of Asian Affairs.

Volume I includes 341 entries from 46 sources; Volume II includes 175 entries from 37 sources.
