The Ben & Hilda Katz Postdoctoral Fellowship in Neurobehavioural Research has recently been established at the Rotman Research Institute of Baycrest Centre for Geriatric Care in Toronto.

The Rotman Research Institute is dedicated to research into neurobehavioural changes which occur during aging, with a specific focus on memory and frontal lobe functions. Baycrest Centre for Geriatric Care is fully affiliated with the University of Toronto and provides a comprehensive range of inpatient and outpatient services to the elderly in Behavioural Neurology, Geriatric Medicine, Psychiatry, Psychology, Speech Pathology and other therapeutic services.

This is a two-year position. The stipend is equivalent to the fellowship scales of the Medical Research Council of Canada, and includes an allowance for travel and other research expenses.
