We have completed the audit of the books and accounts of the Society for the year ended 31st December, 1972, and report thereon as follows:

Life Membership Fund

The balance standing to the credit of the Fund is now £11,542. This is after crediting £675 in respect of life Membership Subscriptions received during the year and transferring £255 to the General Reserve Account which represents the value of subscriptions of those life members whose memberships ceased during the year.

This Fund has been opened by a transfer of £1,000.00 from the Income and Expenditure Account and expenditure has been incurred during the year of £288.26, leaving a balance of £711.74.
