Dr Nansen was elected a Foreign Honorary Fellow of the Society in 1897, and died at Lysaker, near Oslo, on 13th May 1930. (For details of his life and work see Notices in *Geographical Journal* (now being prepared) and *Scottish Geographical Magazine*, July 1930, etc.)

SIR GEORGE ARCHDALL O'BRIAN REID, K.B.E., M.B., C.M., was born at Roorky, India, on 7th April 1860. He was educated privately, and graduated in Medicine and Surgery at the University of Edinburgh. He resided in India and New Zealand, travelled extensively, and was the author of the following volumes: Present Evolution of Man (1896); Alcoholism: a Study in Heredity (1901); The Principles of Heredity (1905); The Laws of Heredity (1910); Prevention of Venereal Disease (1920); and of numerous papers in scientific periodicals. Sir George was also co-editor of Bedrock.

He was elected a Fellow in 1902, and died on 19th November 1929.
