

A new journal, **PHILOSOPHY AND LITERATURE**, is planned for publication at the University of Michigan-Dearborn.

At present no periodical exists which addresses itself directly to the interconnections between philosophical and literary studies. Yet philosophy courses making use of works of literature are increasingly being taught in colleges and universities, and the investigation of philosophical themes has always played an important role in literary criticism. **PHILOSOPHY AND LITERATURE** will thus provide a needed forum for scholars who recognize and wish to explore the relationship between philosophy and literary arts (including the dramatic media of theatre and film). The journal will also publish book reviews and a limited amount of work dealing with general issues in the aesthetics of literature.

**PHILOSOPHY AND LITERATURE** is scheduled to appear next year. Inquiries regarding the submission of manuscripts, subscriptions, and other matters should be directed to Professor Denis Dutton, Department of Humanities, University of Michigan-Dearborn, 48128.
