Case no. 2747. Strophomena de Blainville, 1825 (Brachiopoda): proposed designation of Leptaena planumbona Hall, 1847 as the type species. Abstract. The purpose of this application is to stabilize

the name of the Ordovician brachiopod genus *Strophomena* de Blainville, 1825 by designating *Leptaena planumbona* Hall, 1847 as its type species in place of the poorly known species *Strophomena rugosa* de Blainville, 1825.

Case no. 2736. *Haustator* Montfort, 1810 (Mollusca, Gastropoda): proposed conservation.

Abstract. The purpose of this application is the conservation of the turritellid generic name *Haustator* Montfort, 1810 by the suppression of *Aculea* Perry, 1810, an unused senior subjective synonym.

Case no. 2732. Ceratites nodosus (Cephalopoda, Ammonoidea): proposed attribution of the specific name to Schlotheim, 1813, and proposed designation of a lectotype.

Abstract. The purpose of this application is to conserve the name of the Triassic ammonite *Ceratites nodosus* (Schlotheim, 1813) in its current usage by designation of a lectotype from Schlotheim's original collection.
