P-685 - THERAPY GROUP AND WORK AT THE ACUTE FORENSIC WARD

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Therapy Group consisted usually of 6 to 10 forensic patients, who are at the AFW. Therapy Sessions are twice a week, last - per an hour. The choice of Themes is mainly spontaneous one, with the preliminary about ten minutes time to know how the patients are, what are the news for everyone of them, is there any question, individually or at the ward, to be subjected within the group - here and now. During the time the working theme could arise in the frame of reference of the group, such as - some questions, associations, propositions, whether some member(s) of the group or therapist, could give... The therapy work strategy is concentrated to the themes directly connected to the patients. The work may concern the life and living needs and problems at ward, the mutual relationship, and, especially, the events and people from the past and nowadays of the any of group members. Their experience includes the topics, valid for the general mental energy, wellbeing, better health condition, contacts to the world, family, thinking, emotional needs, hope, contact to the basic living conflicts with the possibilities of solving, the skills, knowledge, memories... The themes have some order however - the memories of early childhood concerning some close and fine experience, connect to the memories of more events with the good experience, the later childhood follows the early childhod, some good primary family members could associate some cousins, etc...
