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1994 Modern Language Association Prize for Independent Scholars

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To recognize and further encourage the achievements and contributions of independent scholars, the Modern Language Association invites nominations for the twelfth annual MLA Prize for Independent Scholars, to be awarded for a distinguished scholarly book published in 1994 in the field of English or another modern language or literature. Under the auspices of the MLA Committee on Honors and Awards, the prize will be presented to an author who, at the time of publication of the book, was not enrolled in a program leading to an academic degree and did not hold a tenured, tenure-accruing, or tenure-track position in a postsecondary educational institution. Tenure is understood to include any comparable provision for job security in an academic setting. Authors of nominated books need not be members of the association. The award, which consists of a check for \$1,000, a certificate, and a one-year membership in the association, will be presented to the winning author at the association's annual convention in December 1995.

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Theatre Survey, the official journal of the Society, is published twice a year, in May and November. The Annual Meeting of the ASTR occurs each fall.
