<b>ADI:</b>	Alzheimer's Disease International
<b>ADL:</b>	Activities of daily living
<b>ARWMC:</b>	age-related white matter changes. ARWMC is a commonly used rating scale in MRI and CT
<b>bvFTD:</b>	Frontotemporal dementia, behavioural variant
<b>CBD:</b>	Corticobasal degeneration
<b>CBP:</b>	Complete blood picture
<b>ChEIs:</b>	Cholinesterase inhibitors
<b>CNS:</b>	Central nervous system
<b>CT:</b>	Computed tomography
<b>CVS:</b>	Cardiovascular system
<b>CXR:</b>	Chest X-ray
<b>DLB:</b>	Dementia with Lewy body
<b>ECG:</b>	Electrocardiography
<b>ESR:</b>	Erythrocyte sedimentation rate
<b>FAST:</b>	Functional Assessment Staging Test
<b>FDG-PET-CT:</b>	Fluorodeoxyglucose-positron emission tomography-computed tomography
<b>GCA:</b>	Global cortical atrophy scale
<b>GDS:</b>	Global Deterioration Scale
<b>GDS-15:</b>	15-item Geriatric Depression Scale
<b>GPCOG:</b>	General Practitioner Assessment of Cognition
<b>HDL-C:</b>	High-density lipoproteins-cholesterol
<b>IA DL:</b>	Instrumental activities of daily living
<b>LDL-C:</b>	Low-density lipoproteins-cholesterol
<b>MCV:</b>	Mean corpuscular volume
<b>MMSE:</b>	Mini-Mental State Examination
<b>MoCA:</b>	Montreal Cognitive Assessment
<b>MRI:</b>	Magnetic resonance imaging
<b>MSU x R/M:</b>	Midstream urine routine microscopy
<b>MTA/MTLA:</b>	Medial temporal lobe atrophy
<b>MTL:</b>	Medial temporal lobe
<b>nfvPPA:</b>	Non-fluent variant primary progressive aphasia
<b>PET:</b>	Positron emission tomography
<b>PiB:</b>	Pittsburgh compound B
<b>PPA:</b>	Primary progressive aphasia
<b>PSP:</b>	Progressive supranuclear palsy
<b>RBD:</b>	Rapid eye movement (REM) sleep behaviour disorder
<b>R/LFT:</b>	Renal and liver function tests
<b>Scheltens:</b>	Medial temporal lobe atrophy (MTA) score, also known as Scheltens' scale
<b>SDH:</b>	Subdural haematoma
<b>SL:</b>	Sublingual
<b>SOL:</b>	Space-occupying lesion
<b>SPECT:</b>	Single-photon emission CT
<b>SSRIs:</b>	Selective serotonin reuptake inhibitors
<b>TSH:</b>	Thyroid-Stimulating Hormone-Sensitive
<b>SVD:</b>	Subcortical vascular dementia
<b>svPPA:</b>	Semantic variant primary progressive aphasia
<b>TCHL:</b>	Total cholesterol

TG:	Triglycerides
tSAH:	Traumatic subarachnoid haemorrhage
TSH:	Thyroid-stimulating hormone
VDRL:	Venereal disease research laboratory test
