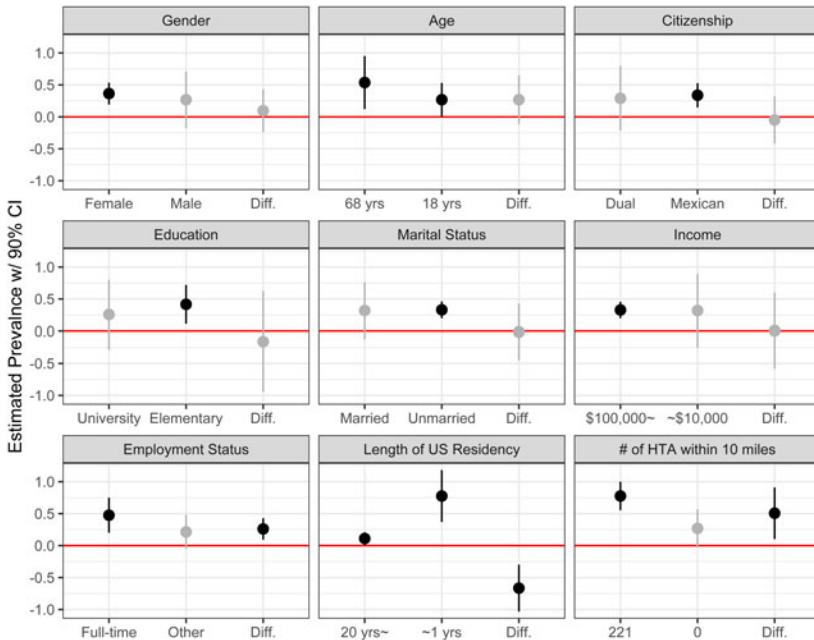


Figure 1. The Effect Size of All Covariates
