Responsibilities include:

Collecting, collating, and classifying epidemiological and quality improvement data required by the Infection Control Program such as data on risk factors, infections, and patient care practices; investigating unusual infections and significant clusters of infections for their possible sources; assisting with special studies as required.

Reviewing and analyzing epidemiological data to identify unusual infections and significant clustering of infections and to determine trends in infection patterns and antimicrobial resistance; determining infection rates based on risk stratification of patients.

Reporting data in a systematic, effective manner: maintains a current listing of nosocomial and other significant infections as indicated for review by the Epidemiologist and Infection Control Coordinator; preparing a monthly report of nosocomial infections for review by the Infection Control Committee; presenting verbal summaries of monthly infections to Committee; and interfacing between the hospital, physicians, and Health Department (or other community agencies) for infectious disease reporting and control.

Identifying and investigating environmental infection hazards and recommend methods to eliminate/control problems.

Qualifications include:

Bachelor of Science Degree in Nursing or other health-related field; post-graduate courses in Epidemiology or Infection Control desirable.

One to two years' clinical nursing experience required, with two to three years' recent experience in hospital infection control preferred.

Completion of CDC or APIC sponsored infection control training desirable.

Current Texas licensure as an RN.

CBIC certification in Infection Control preferred.
