#### **NOTES TO CONTRIBUTORS**

- 1. Contributions to *Children Australia* from those interested in the well-being of children are encouraged. The preferred length of article is 3500-4000 words. Longer articles on topics of particular significance may be accepted in consultation with the editor.
  - The journal would also welcome brief reports of research or policy and program developments (500-1500 words).
- 2. Contributions should be submitted on IBM formatted disk, preferably using Word for Windows Version 6.0, or a compatible program. Three hard copies of the manuscript should also be submitted.
- 3. Document setup should include A4 size paper; double line spacing; wide margins.
- 4. REFERENCES: Please ensure that your references are accurate. References should be referred to in the text by quoting in brackets the surname of the author and year of publication of source material, and then listed in alphabetical order at the end of the article as follows:
  - BOOKS: author's surname and initials; year of publication; title of book in italics; name of publisher; location of publisher; page reference if appropriate.
  - ARTICLES: author's surname and initials; year of publication; title of article; title of journal in italics; volume and issue number; page reference.
- 5. Do not use footnotes, and keep endnotes to a minimum.
- 6. Each article should be prefaced by a brief abstract of the article.
- 7. Contributors are requested to submit brief biographical details, together with a contact address, for inclusion with their article.
- 8. All articles submitted will be reviewed by three referees. Manuscripts may be accepted for publication, returned for revision, or rejected. The Editor's decision is final.
