Individuals living outside the United States who wish to receive the African Studies Newsletter, the African Studies Review, and Issue: A Quarterly Journal of Africanist Opinion are invited to become members of the ASA. Rates for 1975 are as follows: Individuals—\$25.00 (surface mail), \$55.00 (airmail); Students—\$12.00 each year for a maximum of three years (surface mail), or \$42.00 (airmail); Institutions—\$40.00 (surface mail), or \$70.00 (airmail).
