### THE PARABLES OF CHRIST

WITH NOTES FOR PREACHING AND MEDITATION

Fundamental truths are always capable of simple enunciation; and He who supremely understood the human understanding and the human heart chose to enshrine almost all His basic teachings in the setting of parables. These parables and their messages constitute today a very substantial part of the richest treasure, not only of Christian believers, but of the whole human race. They express ideals and convey lessons without which it is almost universally conceded man and his society must vanish from the earth.
