#### SUCH IS MY BELOVED

Morley Callaghan. Introduction by Malcolm Ross. A war-hearted story, quietly and simply told, about a young Catholic priest's disastrous attempt to help two prostitutes during the dark days of the depression. In 1934, when the novel first appeared some of its readers were shocked by the subject and by the treatment also, for Callaghan makes no moral judgments in favour of the "respectable" elements in the society he describes.

#### OVER PRAIRIE TRAILS

Frederick Philip Grove. Introduction by Malcolm Ross. Seven vivid sketches of journeys made in 1917-18 by buggy and cutter over some rough roads west of Winnipeg. Grove, a born traveller, was in his element during those solitary and often hazardous drives; he loved horses, and wilderness, and weather, and he describes all three with matchless precision and verve.

#### LITERARY LAPSES

Stephen Leacock. Introduction by Robertson Davies. Lovers of Stephen Leacock will be delighted to see the new edition of this outstanding classic, and to refresh their memories with many favourite anecdotes. "Boarding-House Geometry", "My Financial Career", and "The New Pathology", as well as the famous stories of the young man who died from his inability to tell a lie, of the baby who ate thirteen Christmas dinners, and the Chinese laundryman's friend, are among the many well-loved and witty tales to be found among its pages.

#### AS FOR ME AND MY HOUSE

Sinclair Ross. Introduction by Roy Daniells. First published in 1941 and too long out of print, this is considered by many to be one of Canada's greatest novels. The setting is Saskatchewan during the cruel years of the drought, in the small town Horizon, which is a replica of countless small towns in the west. The story is told from the point of view of a wife, a woman of courage, insight, and warm sympathy, who battles against the excessive physical and cultural limitations of her environment with all the resources of her nature.
