By **WALTER E. BUNDY**

IN this book, a dispassionate and illuminating sequel to the author's *A Syllabus and Synopsis of the First Three Gospels*, Mr. Bundy demonstrates conclusively that the Synoptic materials fall within the category of tradition rather than history and biography, and shows how the portrayal of Jesus changes constantly throughout them.

Mr. Bundy makes a systematic analysis of each story, each saying, each bit of dialogue, and even each editorial note and comment in the different forms and versions in which they appear. He thus lays before the serious reader and special student the Synoptic materials themselves, acquaints him with the nature, probable origin, and purpose of the early Christian tradition as deposited in the Gospels of Matthew, Mark, and Luke; and assists him in assessing their probable historical value for the knowledge of Jesus as a great man of the past. There is no other work in English which compares in such detail the different versions of the material in the Synoptic Gospels, or which provides so complete a compendium of criticism in the Synoptic field.

Mr. Bundy, the noted Biblical scholar, is Professor of Bible at DePauw University, and is the author of many important books in the Biblical field.
