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ABSTRACT—An informative abstract must accompany each manuscript except for reviews and short paleontological or taxonomic notes. Include all new taxonomic names.

GENERAL

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Figures.—All illustrations, including maps, geologic sections, and half-tone illustrations (including “plates”) are called figures and must be numbered in the same sequence as their first reference in the text. Citations for the illustrations in the text shall be spelled out in full (e.g., Figure 3 or Figure 3.1).

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REFERENCES

Reference to recent Journal articles will provide information on style. Entries are listed alphabetically. The names of authors will be typed in all capital letters. No abbreviations will be used in article and book titles. Journal titles are written out, not abbreviated.
