OFFICIAL LISTS AND INDEXES OF NAMES AND WORKS IN ZOOLOGY

This single volume records for the first time all the animal names and titles of works on which the International Commission on Zoological Nomenclature has ruled since it was set up in 1895.

There are 9,900 entries and 366 pages in this hardbacked volume, size A 4 (210 mm × 295 mm). For easy reference the entries are arranged alphabetically in four sections: family-group names, generic names, specific names, and titles of works.

For quick identification of the status of each name, the List entries are in bold type and the Index entries in nonbold type.

This volume is an essential reference book for all zoologists and paleontologists, and ought to be available in your Institute's library. POLICY ON ILLUSTRATIONS FOR THE JOURNAL

Beginning with the January 1988 issue, the *Journal of Paleontology* will change to a page size of $8\frac{1}{2} \times 11$ inches. Therefore, effective immediately, figures accompanying manuscripts submitted for publication must be at full page size of 18.3×23.3 cm, or at double column width of 18.3 cm, or at single column width of 9.0 cm. All figures must be submitted at publication size and each mounted upon $8\frac{1}{2} \times 11$ in. (21.5×28 cm) white cardboard. Background may be either white or black. Only original prints of half-tone illustrations will be accepted, because those that previously have been screened will not provide acceptable reproduction. Use numbers (not letters) to identify multiple parts of a figure. Half-tones mounted as multiple square or rectangular parts of a figure should be butted together along straight lines with numbers affixed on the lower right-hand corners of the different parts.
