This book brings together in a single volume the principal international conventions, declarations and instruments governing the law of international migration. There are extracts from instruments governing human rights and full texts of the principal treaties and declarations governing nationality, the protection of refugees and migrant labour. There are also the texts of the principal items of legislation of the European Communities and the principal instruments adopted by the Council of Europe, the Benelux Community and the economic communities of West and Central Africa, and of the Caribbean.

Although designed as a publication in its own right, Basic Documents on International Migration Law also serves as a companion to the editor's International Migration Law (second revised edition, 1988), which contains a commentary on the instruments contained in this volume, together with other material.

Richard Plender is a practising barrister and a teacher of International and European Law at King's College, London. He was sometime Legal Secretary to the European Court at Luxembourg and Legal Adviser to the UNHCR.
